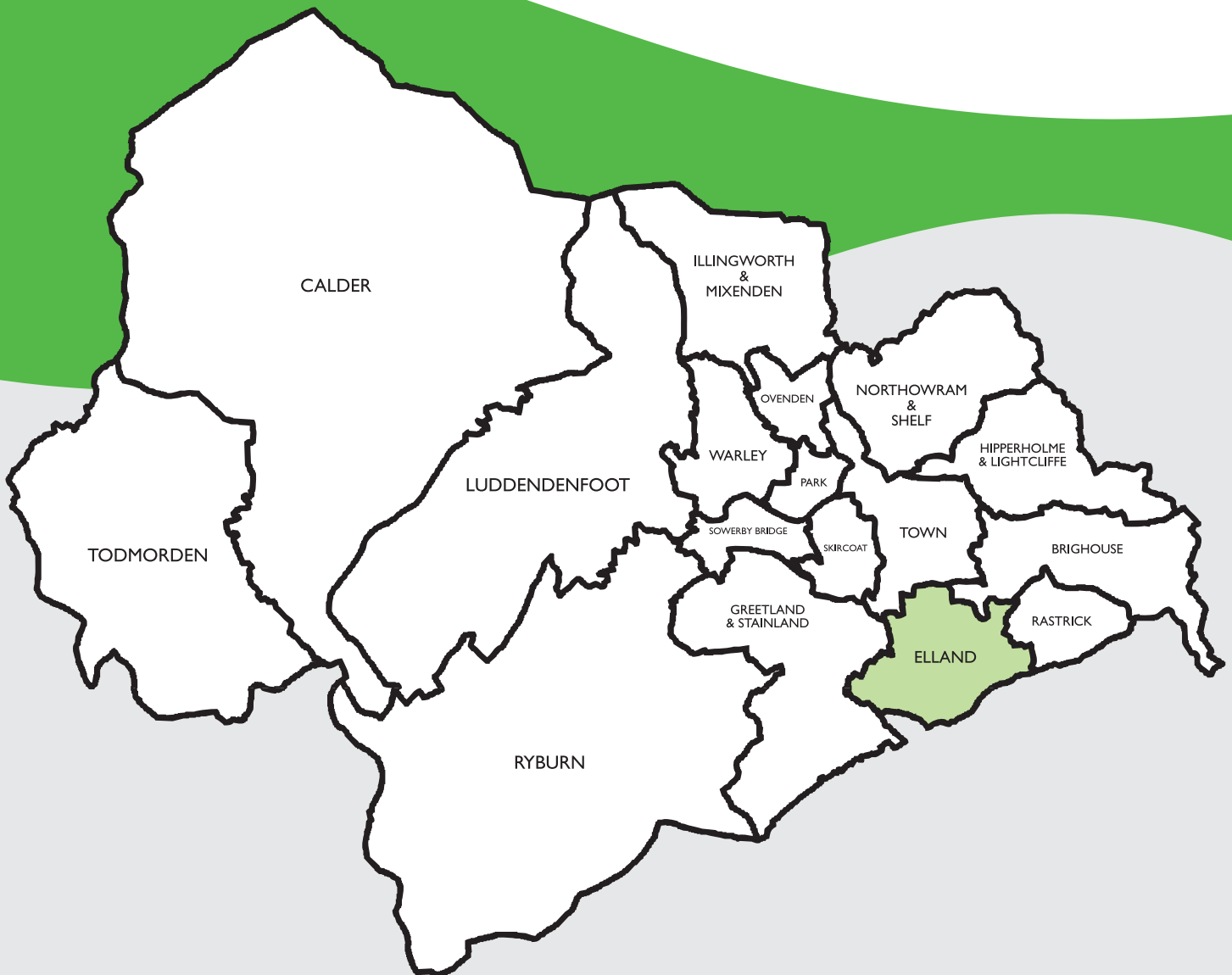
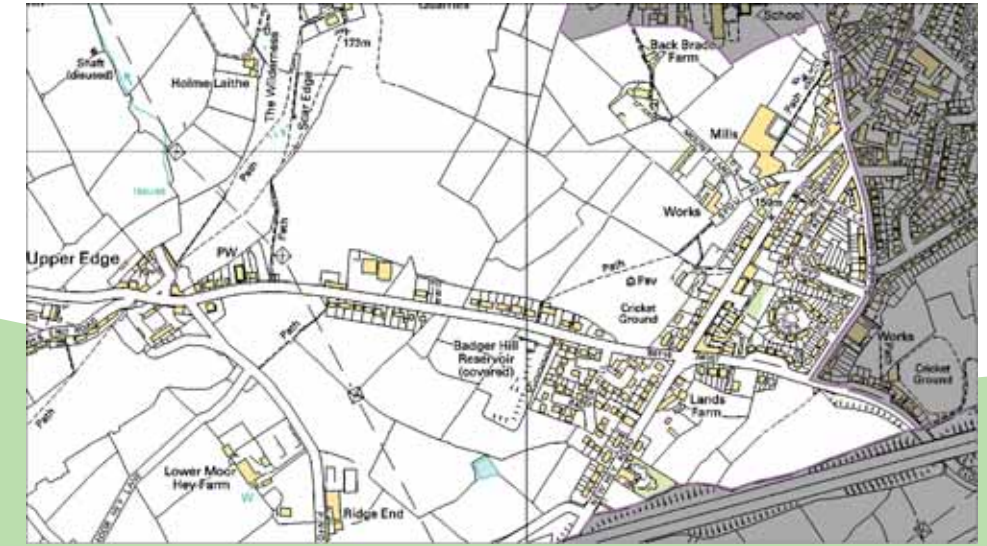

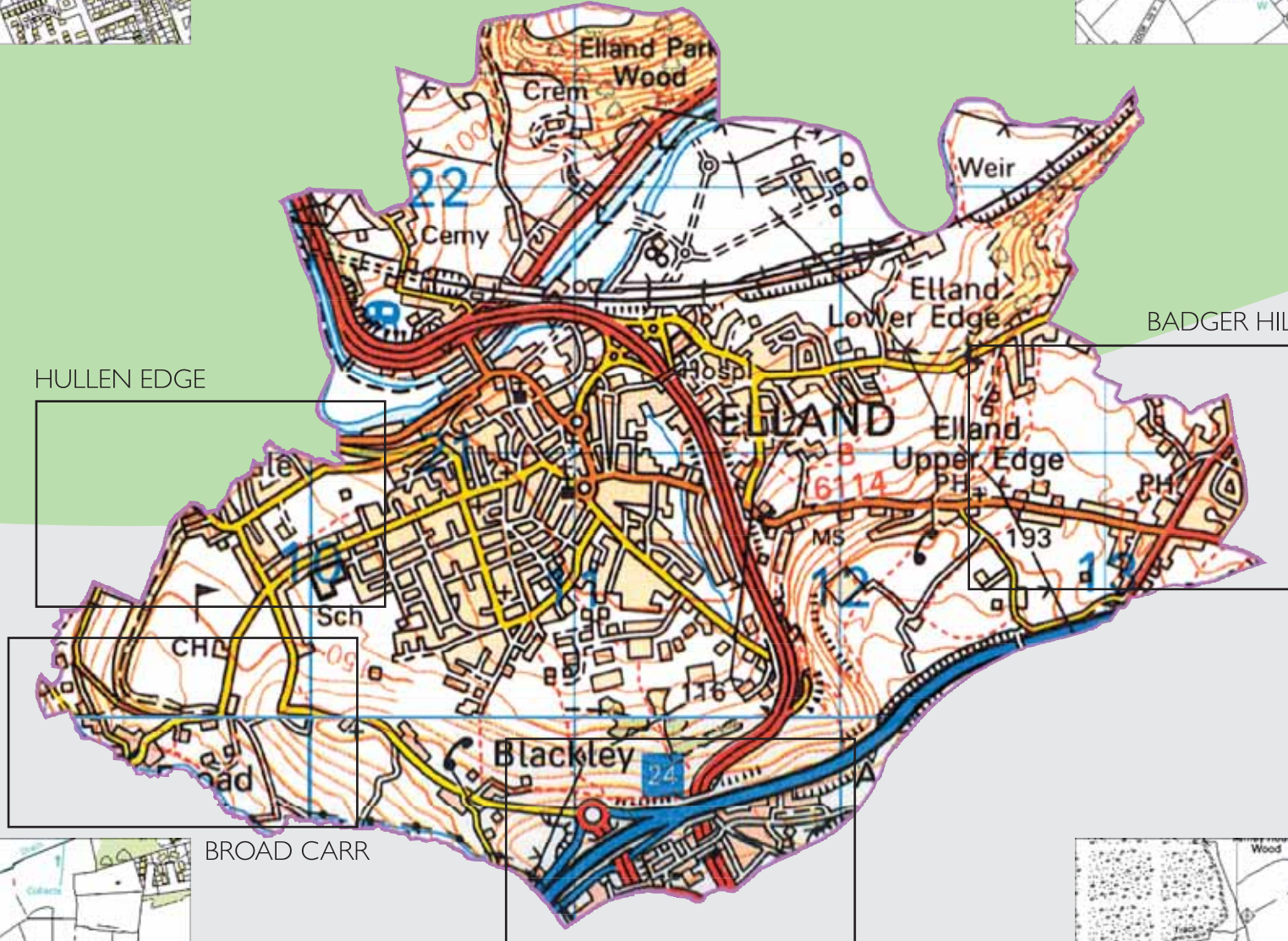

ELLAND WARD

Elland ward is located in south-east Calderdale, includes Elland town itself and a number of smaller settlements such as Blackley, Upper and Lower Edge. The topography slopes steeply from the southern boundary to the river Calder and then rises to Elland Park Wood. The town has direct access to the M62 (Junction 24) and the main road (A 629 Calderdale Way) from Huddersfield and the motorway to Halifax sweeps around the east of the town. The Lowfields Business Park is situated north-east of the town centre with access onto the Calderdale Way.
