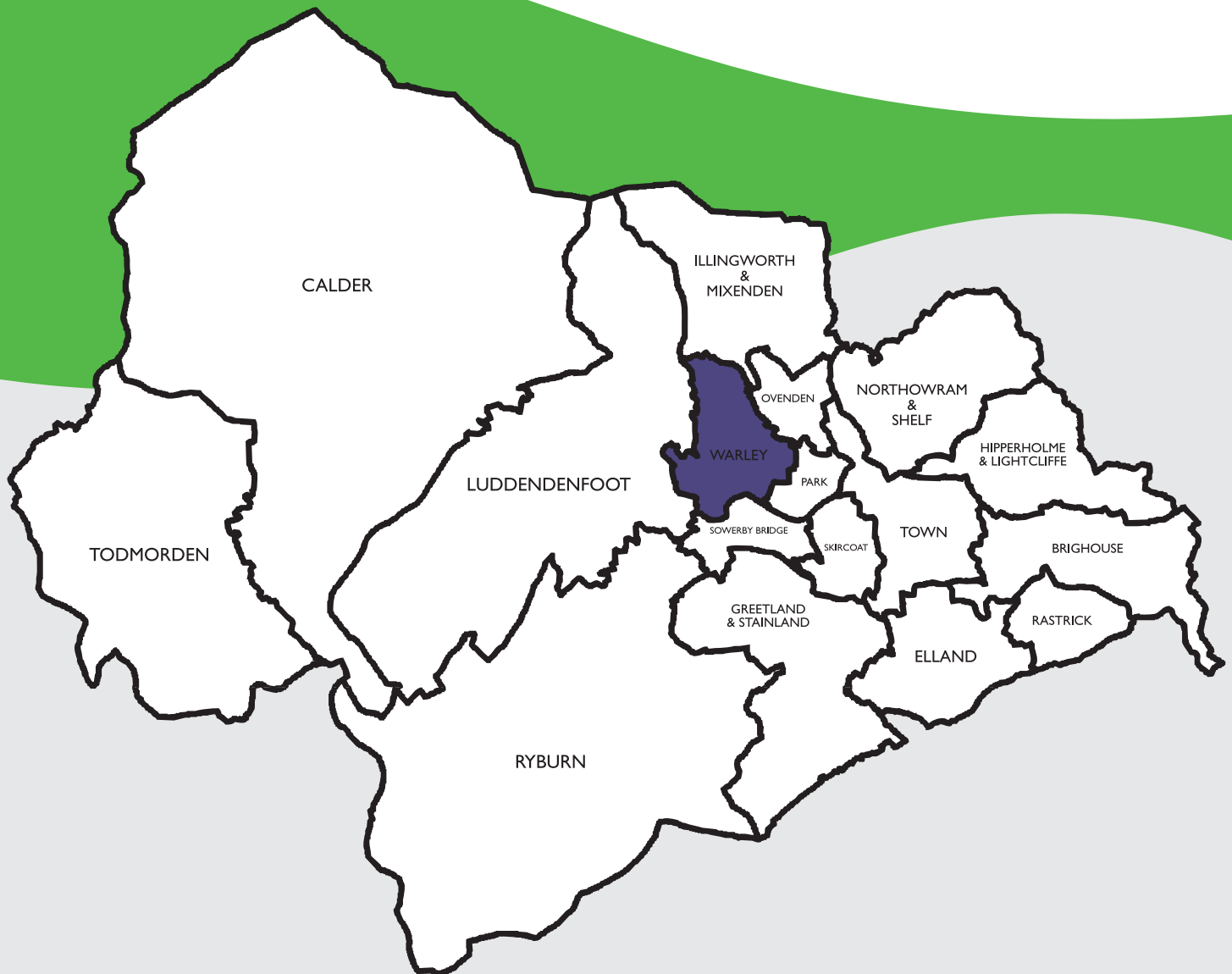
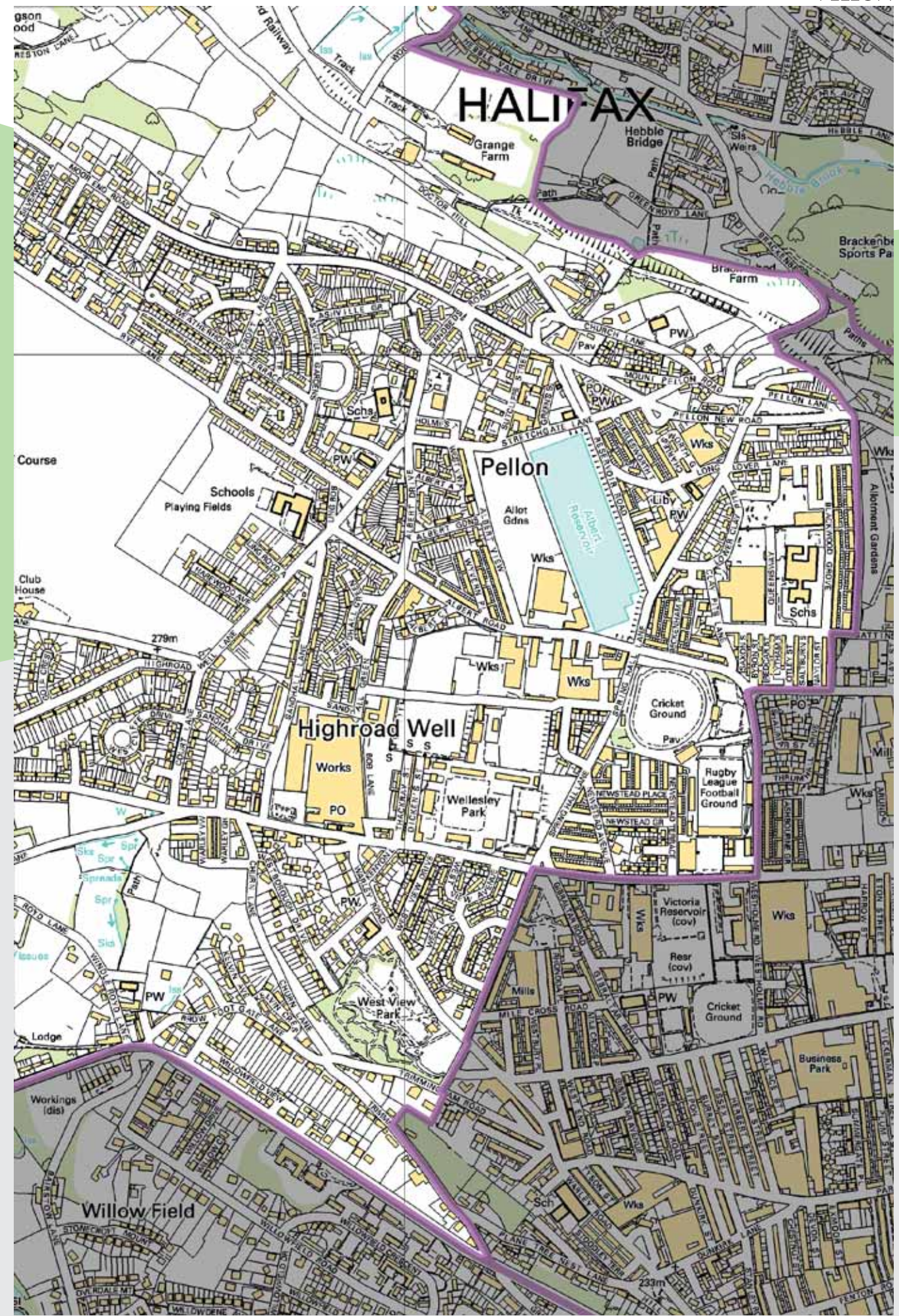

Warley ward is situated on the western side of Halifax and contains several residential areas including Highroad Well, Warley Town, Norton Tower, Pellon, Moor End Road and Mount Tabor. It also includes high open countryside at Highroad Well Moor, around Mount Tabor and west of Norton Tower, overlooking the Luddenden valley.
