

Admission to Brighouse High School – September 2011

YEAR 7

Pupils will be admitted without reference to ability or aptitude. The number of intended admissions for the year commencing September 2011 will be 210.

Where applications for admission exceed the number of places available, the following criteria will be applied in the order set out below, to decide which children will be offered places.

1. Pupils who are in public care.
2. Those children who attend the primary schools of St John's CE (VA) Primary (Clifton), St Andrew's CE (VA) Junior, St Chad's CE (VA) Primary and Withinfields Primary.
3. Those children who have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of their admission and residing at the same address.
4. Children will then be admitted in the order of the proximity of the child's home address to the school. Proximity will be determined by a measured straight line on a map by an electronic Geographical Information System (GIS), from the front entrance of the school at Finkil Street, Brighouse.

YEAR 12

The number of intended admissions for the year commencing September 2011 will be 60. These places are in addition to those available for students who have already been attending the School in Year 11.

Students entering the School at post-16 will be expected to meet the specified entry criteria for the courses on offer.

Where applications for admission into Year 12 exceed the number of places available, the following criteria will be applied to decide which students to admit:

1. Students who are in public care.
2. Those students who have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of their admission.
3. Students will be admitted in the order of the proximity of their home address to the school. Proximity will be determined by a measured straight line on a map by an electronic Geographical Information System (GIS), from the front entrance of the 6th Form Centre at Parsonage Lane, Brighouse.

The school participates in the co-ordinated admission scheme administered by Calderdale Council's Children and Young People's Services Directorate.
