Any person aggrieved by the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SCI. Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the SCI has not been prepared within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or that a requirement of the said Act or associated Regulations have not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the day on which the SCI was adopted, which was 13 th February 2008.
