# NOTES ACCOMPANYING 'SITE SUBMISSION FORM'

## Purpose of the exercise

- To enable all interested parties including landowners and developers to inform the Council of potential development sites in order to produce an evidence base of sites to draw on during preparation of the Local Development Framework (LDF).
- The front loading process does not have a specified end date but the earlier the sites are received the greater the opportunity for the Council to consider them during the preparation of the LDF.

**PROPOSING A SITE AT THIS STAGE DOES NOT NECESSARILY MEAN THAT IT WILL BE ALLOCATED IN THE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK. THE CHOICE OF SITES TO BE SELECTED FOR INCLUSION IN THE LDF WILL NOT BE MADE UNTIL LATER IN THE PLAN MAKING PROCESS AND IN FULL CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMUNITY AND STAKEHOLDERS.**

## Type of Site to be put forward

- Sites capable of any land use including housing, employment, commercial, leisure, retail or a mix of these.
- At this stage there is no restriction on the location or size of site in order that as many potential sites as possible are identified. Whilst planning policy designations remain important, at this stage a "policy neutral" stance is being adopted since such designations may change as the LDF progresses. This will ensure a comprehensive evidence base for the LDF.
- If submitting multiple sites please use a separate form for each.

## Information To Submit

- **Completed form** - the information required should be self-explanatory but any queries should be addressed to the Planning Policy Team on 01422 392381 or by email to [spatial.planning@calderdale.gov.uk](mailto:spatial.planning@calderdale.gov.uk). Please include as much information as possible in order to assist with the assessment of the site.
- **Site plan** - all sites must be accompanied by an Ordnance Survey based location plan preferably at 1:1250 scale or at least 1:2500 scale which shows the direction of North. This plan must clearly show the boundaries of the site edged in red. A single copy of an Ordnance Survey plan can be obtained by visiting Planning Services Reception (Northgate House, Halifax). Alternatively there are a number of websites from which plans can be purchased.
- Please continue on separate sheets if necessary.

Please note for the evidence gathering stage that receipt of the submitted forms will not be formally acknowledged by the Council.
