

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE
(*CROSS LEE ROAD, TODMORDEN*)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2012



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Enterprise PLC** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of *Cross Lee Road* from its junction with *the A646 Burnley Road and Mons Road* for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT pedestrian access is maintained at all times AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained.

The alternative route is *via the Ashenhurst Road, Dineley Avenue, the unaffected part of Cross Lee Road* and vice versa.

It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 20th February 2012 and remain in force until the 12th March 2012 (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
