

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE  
(DUDWELL LANE, SKIRCOAT GREEN)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)  
ORDER 2012



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Centurion Site Services** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no one shall cause or permit any vehicle or persons to proceed in the length of *Dudwell Lane carriageway or footway from its junction with the A629 Huddersfield Road for a distance of approximately 70 metres in a southerly direction.*

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT pedestrian access is maintained at all times via the alternative route AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT *vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained to closure point.*

*The alternative route for vehicles and pedestrians is via the A629 Huddersfield Road, Dryclough Lane, Skircoat Green Road, Godfrey Road and vice versa.*

**It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 6<sup>th</sup> February 2012 and remain in force until the 31<sup>st</sup> July 2012** (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
