

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE  
(TOWN HALL STREET, SOWERBY BRIDGE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)  
ORDER 2012



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Centurion Site Services** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no one shall cause or permit any vehicle or persons to proceed in the length of *Town Hall Street carriageway or footway for a distance of approximately 20 metres on either side of the railway bridge.*

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT pedestrian access is maintained at all times via the alternative route AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT *vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained.*

*The alternative route for vehicles is via the unaffected part of Town Hall Street, Wharf Street, Bolton Brow, the A6026 Wakefield Road, Stainland Road, the B6113 Rochdale Road, Greetland Road, Elland Road, the A58 Halifax Road, the B6113 Rochdale Road and vice versa.*

*The alternative route for pedestrians is via the opposite footway.*

**It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and remain in force until the 15<sup>th</sup> April between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00** (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
