THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE
(THE A629 ORANGE STREET, HALIFAX)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2012



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Marshall Construction Ltd** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of *the A629 Orange Street, Halifax* on the east carriageway (town centre inbound) *between Orange Street roundabout and Broad Street* for a distance of approximately 150 metres.

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road *AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained to closure point.*

The alternative route is *via Pellon Lane slip road, Pellon Lane and Broad Street.*

It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 9th January 2012 and remain in force until the 18th March 2012 (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
