

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE
(BLACKLEDGE, HALIFAX)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2011



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Geo Houlton & Sons Ltd** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no one shall cause or permit any vehicle or persons to proceed in the length of *Blackledge carriageway or footway from its junction with Thomas Street for a distance of approximately 30 metres in an easterly direction.*

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT pedestrian access is maintained at all times via the alternative route AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT *vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained to closure point.*

The alternative route is via Horton Street and vice versa.

It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 7th November 2011 and remain in force until the 6th November 2012 (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
