(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2008



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale because of works by **Enterprise Plc** on or near the road intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of *Brookfoot Lane & Church Lane* from 10 metres west of the entrance to Marshall Quarry to 40 metres west of *Birks Royd* for a distance of approximately 450 metres.

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with works being carried out on or near the road AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT pedestrian access is maintained at all times AND PROVIDED ALSO THAT *vehicular access for the emergency services is maintained to closure point.*

The alternative route is *via the unaffected part of Brookfoot Lane, Elland Road, Halifax Road, Brighouse Road, Leeds Road, Godley Lane, New Bank, around the Gyratory, Godley Road, Beacon Hill Road, Law Lane, Cain Lane, the unaffected part of Church Lane* and vice versa.

It is proposed that the Order will come into operation on the 11th August 2008 and remain in force until the 31st August 2008 (although it can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
