

Calderdale Metropolitan Borough Council

Decision Statement published pursuant to Regulations 19 and 20 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. Notice is hereby given that at the Council meeting on 22nd March 2023 Calderdale Metropolitan Borough Council formally decided to make (adopt) the Park Ward Neighbourhood Development Plan under Section 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended).

This means the Park Ward Neighbourhood Development Plan has now been brought into legal force, forming part of the statutory development plan for Calderdale. Consequently, the plan will be used to determine planning applications in the Park Ward Neighbourhood Plan Area.

Reasons for decision: The Park Ward Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the basic conditions and is compliant with legal and procedural requirements. Paragraph 38A (4) (a) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 requires the Council to make the Neighbourhood Plan if more than half of those voting in the referendum upon the plan have voted in favour of the plan being used to inform planning applications in the area.
