Motives of the Applicants

20. The Objector makes a number of points about the motives of the Association in seeking to register the s submitted that motives are irrelevant for the purposes of village green stration. The only question for the Registration Authority is whether the in fact, a town or village green having regard to the registration criteria.

Summary

21. It is submitted that the issues raised by the objector would not enable the Registration Authority to lawfully reject our client's application without further investigation. Most of the points raised dispute the extent and nature of use.
22. We submit that the appropriate next step on the part of the Registration Authority should be to appoint an independent inspector to advise on the application and that the matters should proceed by way of a local inquiry.
