Street Cleaning

In the last twelve months Safer Cleaner Greener have;

- Cleaned 32,775km of public roads and footways
- Emptied 1,500 litter bins
- Removed 1,973 reported incidents of fly tipping
- Removed 253 reported incidents of graffiti

Safer Cleaner Greener with our Partners

- Safer, Cleaner, Greener area teams work closely with partner agencies e.g. Pennine Housing, NHS England, Calderdale College, Workwise
- Multi agency action days such as the Big Clean Up campaign have proved to be very successful at responding to local community needs and tackling environmental issues
- Excellent working relationships have been established with emergency response teams. This has proved successful in responding to flooding in the Upper Valley

Our Vision for the future

- Closer working relationship with other front line services to enhance the work we already do for local communities
- Build on our partnership work e.g. maintenance agreements with Pennine Housing, use of Manor Heath by Calderdale College, funding apprenticeships
- Support community groups to work more independently



Our Vision for the future

- Since 2010 staff numbers have reduced by 50 and the budget has reduced by almost £1m
- Despite this SCG are still delivering, many compliments are being received and the KPI's are consistent. The YTD result for litter is 4% and for detritus is 8% (low is good).
- Rationalisation of vehicles from 60 to 39 has saved the Council £96k since 2010. The Councils Transport Services Review may require us to further rationalise vehicles down to 27 meaning a 55% reduction since 2012



Our Vision for the future



- A large service area constantly facing changes
- Maximise the use of fewer vehicles e.g. double shift arrangement
- Introduce a 7 day working week
- Proposals in line with APSE report findings on 'Efficiencies in Street-Scene Services'
