

# APPENDIX 2

## Regarding the licence for La Salsa

We would like the council to remove the condition 6 'Removing of G string' from our Licensing Conditions, for the following reasons:

1. All our dancers are coming from neighbouring towns like Leeds and Manchester where they have different dance policies (where the dancers are allowed to remove their G String). New dancers from these towns are accustomed to the dance policy of their own towns where they have been trained. Every week we have to re-train the dancers with our policies and need to keep going onto the Dance Floor in front of customers to warn the dancers to keep their G Strings on. This creates a lot of tension in the club and creates a bad service to customers.
2. Most customers are also accustomed to the policies from neighbouring towns like Leeds and Manchester and expect to receive the same service in Halifax. When they do not get the service they expected, they will demand a refund which also creates tension and there have also been some fights as well. This puts managers and dancers in danger. (There are also warning signs about the dance around the club but not everyone will read them)
3. Most customers are also large groups such as Stag Do's and Birthday parties. These customers also expect the same service as other towns but when they find out about the restrictions in Halifax this makes them leave the town altogether and go elsewhere. This in effect loses business for Halifax Town's Night Life overall.
