<p>At the end of 2019, Healthwatch published a report regarding the service of CAMHS/Assessments – which is supplied at <i>Appendix A</i>. More information can be found via: https://www.healthwatchcalderdale.co.uk/news/our-work-on-camhs-in-calderdale-reveals-life-impact-on-children-young-people-and-families/</p> <p>In response to the report findings, a Partnership Response was submitted in January 2020 by Calderdale Council, Calderdale Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG), South West Yorkshire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (SWYPFT), Northpoint Wellbeing Limited and Kooth (online counselling)- and can be found at <i>Appendix B</i>.</p> <p>At the Children and Young People's Scrutiny Board meeting in June 2019, some of the issues raised in these reports had been discussed and a recommendation was made for the Local Authority and Calderdale CCG to supply six monthly briefings (in December 2019 and June 2020) which would monitor the progress of this work and the support to Calderdale children and young people. The first of these briefing notes was shared in January 2020 and can be found at <i>Appendix C</i>.</p> <p>Members agreed that following receipt of the recent information, the item would be formally discussed at the March 2020 Scrutiny Board and all relevant partners would be invited.</p>
