QUESTION

I welcome the announcement in the amended motion at the recent Full Council Meeting confirming that Calderdale Council has adopted the updated fines under the Antisocial Behaviour Action Plan. Please could you confirm whether any of these new fines have been issued, specifically how many were issued for fly-tipping at the maximum level of £1,000 and for littering at £500, and outline what the Council plans to do with the additional revenue.

Response

The Council's Fly-tipping team as part of the wider Community Protection Team have issued 49 fines for Fly-tipping (£1,000) of which 16 have been paid to date.

They have had 22 fines issued for 'Duty of Care' (£150) waste producer's responsibility to dispose of waste appropriately, with 7 paid to date.

We do not have a £500 littering fine; the amount is set at £100.

Income generated from fines is reinvested within the service area to support the work that takes place.
