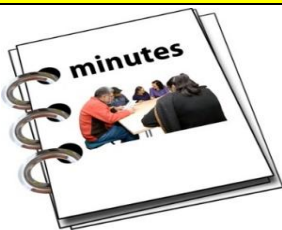

Self-Assessment Framework



Last January Calderdale Council submitted the self assessment. It is now time to re-submit it again. This year we do not need to input for the Self Assessment Framework, we just need to work together after. Transitions Protocol



The transitions Protocol group has been running for about 18 months. The Pathways are now nearly completed and Karen Midgley will present these in the Spring when these are finished. Calderdale are in National Boundaries for people in Assessment and Treatment Units. There is currently 1 person in long term placement but Calderdale have found a service in Manchester to help bring this person back to the community.

Between 19-22 January Calderdale Peer Review will inspect our services such as home care and supported accommodation. Currently a timetable is being put together then people can be contacted to see if they wish to be involved.

Yorkshire and Humber Leadership leaders Meeting

Lead The Way



Facilitated an employment focus group attended by lots of different organisations. We shared experiences of looking for a job and having a job. Lots of work still needs to be done and our next meeting is 20th January 2016 at Threeways. One of the main worries is people living in supported living could lose benefits if they get a job. Also to try get links with somebody who has benefits experience to attend the focus group.

One parent wanted to thank Lead the Way for the Hoot Group in which their Son had attended and said how much he had enjoyed the sessions and was hoping they were to continue.

Councillor Metcalf updated us about the get together event led by the community social work team. This was held at the Elsie Whitely to see what community social work practice will look like. Adult Social Care are looking at a new way of working. The Adult Social Work team are currently looking for a shop in Halifax Town Centre. People can drop in to see them as well this should be ready for April.
