



THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE
(HEBDEN BRIDGE CENTRAL AREA) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008 (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2017

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Calderdale ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to make an order, the effect of which is to introduce on street parking charges in the currently free parking places on; Albert Street, Crown Street, Cheetham Street, Carlton Street and Keighley Road. The hours of operation will be Monday – Sunday 8:00am – 6:00pm, During that time, vehicles may wait for a maximum period of one hour, with a no return period prohibited within 2 hours. There will be a charge of 20p per half an hour, after the initial first 30 minutes being free.

It is also proposed to convert the currently free parking place on Valley Road outside Valley Medical Centre to pay and display, and conversion of the redundant loading bay to pay and display which is located to the east of Northlights Art Studio on Valley Road. The hours of operation will be Monday – Sunday 8:00am – 6:00pm, with a tariff of 60p per hour.

Additionally, to facilitate free passage of traffic on the road it is proposed to make amendments to existing waiting restrictions on Keighley Road.
