



**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (SPEED LIMIT)
(NORWOOD GREEN, SHELF AND STONE CHAIR) ORDER 2016**

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 14 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 that the Borough Council of Calderdale intend to make an order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The order will introduce a 20mph speed limit on the full length (unless specified) of the following roads within the districts:

Norwood Green:

Back Wells Terrace; Chapel Street; Hill End Close; Mayfield; Norwood Green Hill; Norwood Terrace; Queens Road; Rookes Lane (from its junction with Village Street for a distance of approx. 280m); Sowden Lane (from its junction with Village Street for a distance of approx. 165m); Station Road (from its junction with Village Street for a distance of approx. 215m); Shutts Lane (from its junction with Norwood Green Hill for a distance of approx. 100m); The Poplars; Village Street; Watford Avenue; Wells Terrace; Windsor Villas.

Shelf:

Aydonway; Beech Close; Brow Lane; Brow Wood Rise; Brow Wood Road; Brownberry Grove; Burned Grove; Burned Road; Burnside Avenue; Cheapside ; Cloverdale; Delf Close; Elm Grove; Elwell Close; Green Hall Park; Green Lane (from its junction with Brow Lane for a distance of approx. 300m); Greenacres; Greenacres Avenue; Greenacres Drive; Greenacres Grove; Highfield Avenue; Howdenbrook; Laurel Close; Meadow Close; Moor Grove; Primrose Way; Sandall Magna; Shelf Moor; Shelf Moor Road; Soaper Lane (from its junction with Stanage Lane for a distance of approx. 50m); South Lane (from its junction with Shelf Moor Road for a distance of approx. 250m); Stanage Lane (from its junction with Soaper Lane for a distance of approx. 270m); Villa Gardens; Willow Park Drive.

Stone Chair:

Airedale Dr; Beechwood Av; Belle Vue Cres; Belle Vue Rise ; Belle Vue Rd; Broad Ings Way; Burnley Hill Ter; Cock Hill La (from its junction with West St for a distance of approx. 200m); Cross La; Dovedale Cl; Eskdale Av; Grange Bank; Hall Stone Court; Highcliffe Court; Hud Hill; Ings Croft; Moor Stone Pl; Park Stone Rise; Sandmoor Gdns; Score Hill (from its junction with Brighouse and Denholme Gate Rd for a distance of approx. 130 m); Shelf Hall La; Spring Hall Cl; Wade House Av; West St; Wharfedale Mount.
